

The Royal Norwegian Government and Asian Disaster Preparedness Center (ADPC) signs Memorandum of Understanding

The Foreign Ministry of the Royal Norwegian Government and Asian Disaster Preparedness Center (ADPC) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on 27 May 2009 to foster greater co-operation between the two Institutions in the arena of **Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR)** in the region.
