

Capacity Development for Trainers and Learners on Community-based Disaster Risk Reduction in Asia (UNDP-TLC)

Project brief:

- Networking of CBRR trainers and training institutions in the Philippines and India was done under the training learning circle project. Currently, there are 40 members comprised of 15 Universities, 10 training institutions and 15 civil society organizations have been registered in India representing 9 states. In the Philippines, TLC is leading monthly interactive learning events on various subjects for its members and extended audiences. An inventory of CBDRR knowledge products which are available in the region has been developed by the ADPC.
- Two gender sensitive knowledge products have been developed in India under TLC. Those are on Safer Schools and Micro Insurance for Disaster Risk Reduction. Knowledge product on Gender and disaster risk reduction has been developed in the Philippines.
- Scoping study on mainstreaming CBDRR into Universities and training institutions was conducted in India while it was done as a case study in the Philippines. Both scoping study and the case studies are assessing the present situation in institutionalising CBDRR in universities and training institutes and their needs for effective integration into the existing curriculum.
