Project brief:

In the aftermath of cyclone Nargis 2008, a number of agencies are in process of implementing the Community Based Disaster Risk Management (CBDRM) programmes. In order to bring all stakeholders on one page and standardize the CBDRM approach in Myanmar, ADPC has been engaged by UNDP, Myanmar to develop four manuals on four specific themes of CBDRM.

1. First Aid Manual

Status: The draft final report has been prepared and translation is in progress. The field testing will be early September 2009.

2. Search and Rescue Manual

Status: Outline developed and data collection in progress.

3. Community based Disaster Management Planning Manual

Status: Draft final report developed and translation is in progress. Field test in early September 2009.

4. School Safety Manual

Status: Outline developed and data collection in progress. Meeting with MRCS, UNESCO and Save the Children held.
