Activity 2

Establishment of early warning system

The University of Peradeniya has submitted the flood model to NBRO a discussion was held at NBRO on installation of the flood gauges and for planning of several awareness programs at community level.

- Dr. Nandalal will be invited to do a presentation with clarification for the existing confusions on the developed Flood Model by him for the representatives of NBRO and Sarvodaya PROMISE Project Staff in the first week of October.
- Installations of flood gauges are planed to start from the end of October in parallel to the awareness workshops for the communities.

Component2

<u>Community Based Small Scale Projects</u> Activity 1

Several field visits were done to identify the small scale mitigation projects during this month. Identification part of the mitigation projects was completed. PROMISE Sri Lanka team decided to implement four structural mitigations and two non structural mitigations.

Structural Mitigations

1. Elevation of the by road at 729 Nagoda West GN Division to reduce the inundation impact during the rainy season

2. Establish a toilet system in the public fair at Kalutara city proper and at Calido beach.

3. Soil erosion control measures and establish a waste separation system in two selected schools

in Kalutara

4. Improving the Drainage system to address the problem of water logging

Non structure mitigations

5. Program to aware, train and increase the capacities of personnel involved in the construction industry of Kalutara Flood prone area with the support of NBRO

6. Equipping the disaster prevention institutes to increase their coordination capacities.

• Police station of Kalutara North –facilities for public awareness, as a place for gathering of people in a disaster and an information hub.

• With reference to the limitations that Government DMC encountered in the event Sri Lanka expected the second tsunami PROMISE Project planed to strengthen the capacity of it for pre-disaster responsiveness.
