<p>Due to the Cyclone Aila two training events (Khulna and Barisal) were postponed till the situation gets normal in the affected coastal districts of Bangladesh.</p> <p>During the month of June 2009, consultations with the representatives of various government organizations have been conducted for the organization of two remaining events in Khulna and Barisal.</p> <p>Finally, with the consent of CDMP, the dates for Khulna have been finalized and it is being organized from July 14-16, 2009 at Royal International Hotel Khulna. Invitation letters and other logistics arrangements have been made accordingly.</p> <p>The tentative dates for the Barisal training already communicated with CDMP for the confirmation and approval. <p>Preparedness Programme and Red Crescent Society has been invited to participate in the training events.</p>	
<p><b>Printing of Posters and leaflets:</b> During the reporting month intensive consultations and discussions were made with CDMP to finalize the posters.</p> <p>In the first step ADPC produced 10 numbers of posters on different themes on earthquake safety awareness submitted to CDMP for the comments and approval. Finally, CDMP approves five numbers of posters of different themes for the printing in English.</p> <p>During the reporting month ADPC has printed 2500 copies of all five (500 copies of each theme) approved posters.</p> <p>In the second step ADPC has translated the posters in Bangla and submitted to CDMP on June 30, 2009 for the approval of printing. The size and number of posters has been already approved and finalized by CDMP.</p> <p>It is planned that during the month of July, 2009. Printing and dissemination will be completed.</p>	<p><b>Production and dissemination of posters and leaflets on earthquake vulnerability reduction measures</b></p>
<p><b>Preparation of documentary:</b> As per the discussions with CDMP as first close viewing of the documentary has been conducted on June 3, 2009 at ADPC office. Senior members of CDMP, ADPC and BDPC participated the first close viewing. The main purpose of the close viewing was to find out the areas of improvements and devise the strategy for incorporating the comments and suggestion to make it suitable for another close viewing in CDMP. It was agreed that more video clips of other CDMP and ADPC activities would be incorporated and sub-titles translation in English.</p> <p>During the reporting month with the help of Dr. Maksud Kamal, National Expert, CDMP, ADPC initiated to update the documentary according to comments of first close viewing. Seismic micro zonation maps of Bangladesh, Dhaka, Chittagong and Sylhet were incorporated, besides video clips of CDMP and ADPC activities.</p> <p>The first draft of the documentary has been submitted to CDMP on June 28, 2009 for further comments and suggestions for updating the documentary.</p>	<p><b>Preparation of documentary to develop awareness on earthquake hazards and vulnerabilities</b></p>
